

Name of the Game:

TopScramble is a team-based game and can have up to 6 players per team. The object of the game is to earn as many points for your team as possible. Each player will hit 20 balls. (If you have 6 players on your team then the team will be hit a total of 120 shots.)

Scoring:

The score is calculated by taking the highest scoring ball from the team per shot.

For example:

Player	Ball 1	Ball 2	Ball 3	Ball 4	Ball 5
A	3	3	12	11	10
B	5	0	9	9	12
C	10	4	11	7	5
D	4	5	4	4	3
E	7	2	0	20	8
F	8	15	4	8	1

Team Total = 69 points

$$10 + 15 + 12 + 20 + 12 = 69$$

It is possible one player can have the highest score for the team on multiple balls. The game does track each individual score while computing the team score at the same time.

The closer you hit the ball to the center on the target (the flagstick) the more points you will receive. There are more points awarded for hitting it into a further target. This game is looking to reward accuracy and distance.
